- ❖ Jean reported that planning is underway for the 2019 Summer Reading Program. She has signed a contract with MAD SCIENCE to entertain at the celebration for the end of the program. They'll do a stage show called "Destination Moon". The Library received a \$200 grant from the Vermont Department of Libraries for the performers for this celebration.
- ❖ Jean requested Trustees help staffing the Library on May 14 (Janis volunteered) and May 28 (Bronna volunteered).
